

PROJECTED TAX IMPACT

If the capital referendum is approved by voters, the projected tax impact for the 2025-26 school year would be **\$0.47 per \$1,000** of assessed fair market value for a home within the district.



The school district's portion of the property tax mill rate has dropped from \$11.67 in 2018 to \$7.32 in 2024.
